How to apply for a Certified Credential

This guide walks through how to prepare identification documents and apply for a Certified Credential via the myNAATI portal. For any enquiries please contact <u>info@naati.com.au</u>

Preparing identification documents

All applicants will need to attach additional files with their online application.

These files may include:

- a scanned copy of an identification document (e.g., passport or Australian driver's licence)
- a scanned copy of your transcript, proof of enrolment or your certificate of completion
- evidence of English proficiency (not required if an Endorsed Qualification has been completed in the past 3 years).
- evidence of Ethical and/or Intercultural Competency where available (not required if an Endorsed Qualification has been completed in the past 3 years).
- a headshot photo (as per image right)

Submitting an application

Step One - myNAATI Portal

On the myNAATI Home page navigate to the 'SUBMIT AN APPLICATION' icon then to the 'CERTIFICATION & RECOGNISED PRACTISING' icon.

Step Three - Application Selection

Step Four - Credentials

In this section you will need to inform NAATI what Credential you are applying for.

Click on 'NEW CREDENTIAL REQUEST'. Then in the pop up screen enter the following details:

'Category'	Interpreter or Translator
'Type'	Credential name
'Skill'	Search for your Language

If your language does not appear in the list, it may be that it is listed under an alternative name or it is not available for the credential you have chosen.

How to apply for a Certified Credential

Training

To meet the prerequisites of a credential you will need to have completed training in either an 'Endorsed Qualification' (EQ) or a 'Non-Endorsed Qualification'. Click here to view a list of available training courses: https://www.naati.com.au/certification/prerequisites-training/#training

An <u>Endorsed qualification</u> will be a Diploma-level or higher from a Vocational Education & Training (VET) or Higher Education (HE) institution that has been endorsed by NAATI.

A <u>Non-Endorsed Qualification</u> may be a Skill Set course or any other translating or interpreting qualification that has not been endorsed by NAATI, including overseas qualifications.

Step Five(a) - Endorsed Qualification

If you have competed a diploma or higher from a VET or HE institution endorsed by NAATI select 'Yes'.

Then enter the institution, location, qualification name, your student ID, the start and end dates of your qualification and if it has been 3 years or more since you completed.

Step Five(b) - Non-Endorsed Qualification

If you have not competed a diploma or higher from a VET or HE institution endorsed by NAATI select 'No' to both questions about 'Endorsed Qualification' and 'Approved Course'.

If you have competed a Skill Set course or overseas qualification select 'Yes' to 'Non-Endorsed Qualification' then enter your institution, qualification name, your student ID, and the completion date of the qualification.
