Translators deal with the **written** word.

They translate written content from one language to another.

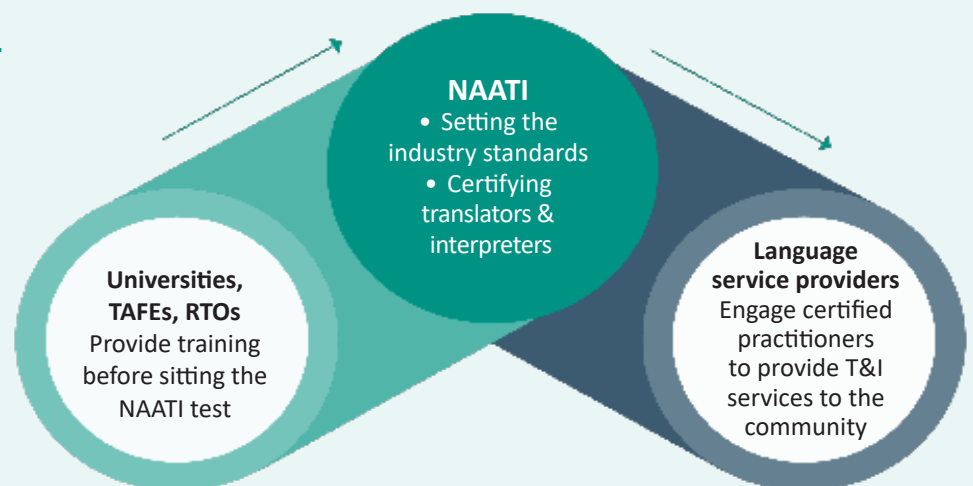


Interpreters deal with the **spoken** word or **signs** (such as Auslan).

They interpret what each speaker is saying or signing into the other person's language.
